

Mathematics and Numeracy	Counting, matching, sorting activities Number recognition and formation, play dice/ domino games. Create repeating patterns. Explore number through Numicon activities discuss more/ less , simple adding and subtracting. Explore 2D and 3D shapes through play.
Languages, Literacy and Communication	Learn and recite nursery rhymes and songs. Introduce initial sounds satipn, ckermhd ; tricky word games and activities; name writing using correct letter formation. Blending sounds Talk for writing- Brown bear story, The Little dinosaur story.
Science and Technology <i>Knowledge and understanding of the world , design and technology</i>	Name and group materials. Notice similarities and differences by exploring properties of materials. Discuss sources of materials- plants/ animals/ minerals - man made/ natural materials
Health and Well-being	The colour Monster story/ Lliwiau Hapus – discuss different feelings, Growth Mindset - learning from our mistakes, and developing positive self-esteem. Outdoor Learning - mud kitchen, digging pit , quarry area, water play, large construction explore and learn about nature in the woods/ field- notice signs of autumn / winter P.E – Mondays- outdoor games- ball skills, throwing/ catching/ team games.
Expressive Arts <i>Art, Dance, Drama, Music, Film and digital media.</i>	Exploring colour through paints, collages, Colour wheel -Primary/ secondary colours Listening to and creating moods in music, dance, act out stories/ emotions through drama and mime.
Humanities <i>History, Geography , Religious Education</i>	Materials through time – stone/ iron/ bronze ages; the dilemma of plastic / recycling materials. Caring and respecting our world. Festivals including Harvest/ Diwali/ Christmas
Cymraeg	Cymraeg - activities, stories, songs and language patterns that develop and encourage understanding, communication and confidence to discuss colours, feelings, weather, clothes, prepositions in Welsh.
