We hope that you all had a lovely summer and had the chance to relax with friends and family. We are all excited to welcome you back to school on **Monday September 6**th.

Although restrictions have been lifted and we are all trying to return to some sort of 'normal', at Ysgol Bro Famau we will continue with some of our Covid measures in order to keep everyone as safe as possible.

Covid Measures

- Pupils displaying symptoms of Covid (new persistent cough, high temperature, loss of sense of smell) should be kept at home and should take a PCR test Anyone who is identified as a close contact of someone with a positive case of Covid can continue to attend school, unless they develop symptoms. They should have a PCR test on day 2 and day 8.
- Foundation Phase and Key Stage 2 will continue to operate as two 'bubbles' with minimum contact
- Pupils will continue with good hand hygiene with regular thorough hand washing
- There will be good ventilation in class
- Pupils are encouraged to limit personal items brought in from home
- All pupils will have a pencil case of regularly used items (e.g. pens, pencil, etc)
- · Masks will still be worn by pupils on buses
- Parents should continue to be socially distanced on the yard and wear a mask.
- Parents should leave the yard as soon as they have collected their child/ren
