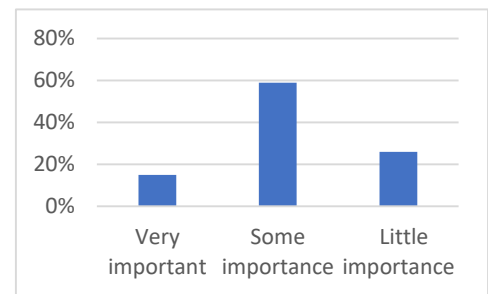

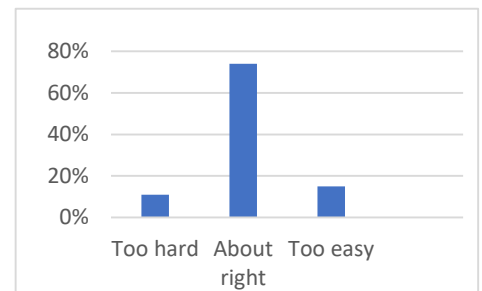
Question 1 - How important do you think homework is to your child's learning?

No importance	0%



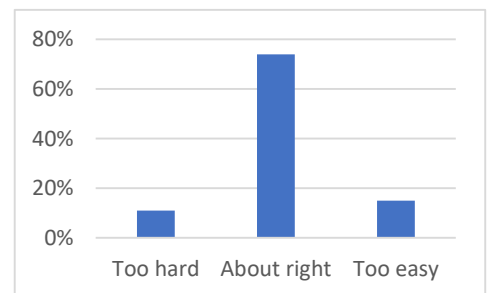
Question 2 - Do you think homework given by school each week is...?

Not enough	18%



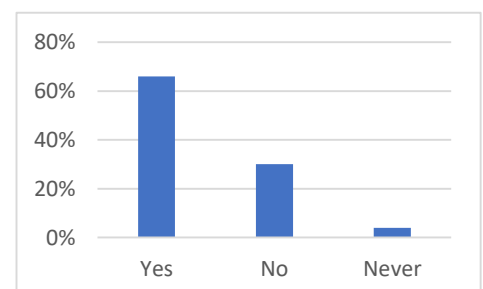
Question 3 – My children find the level of homework.....

Too easy	15%



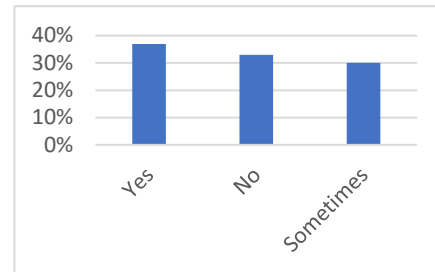
Question 4 – Are you able to help your child/red with their homework?

Never	4%



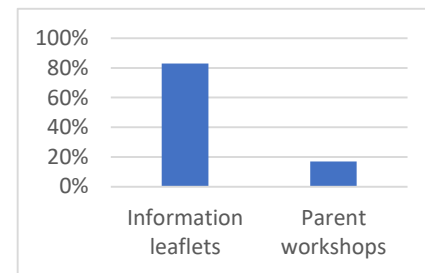
Question 5 – Homework is a cause of tension in our house...

Sometimes	30%



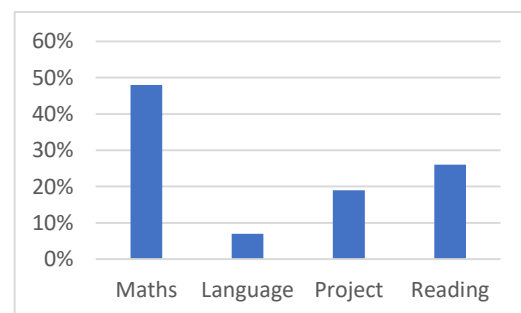
Question 6 -Which of these sources of advice on homework (if any) would you welcome and use if available?

Parent workshops	17%



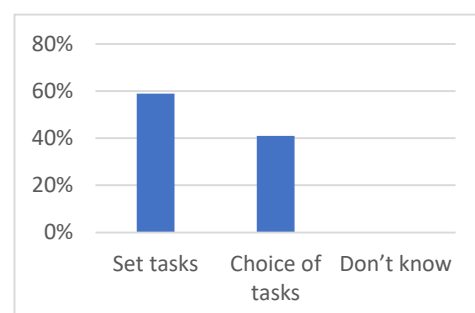
Question 7 – Which type of homework does your child engage most with?

Reading	26%



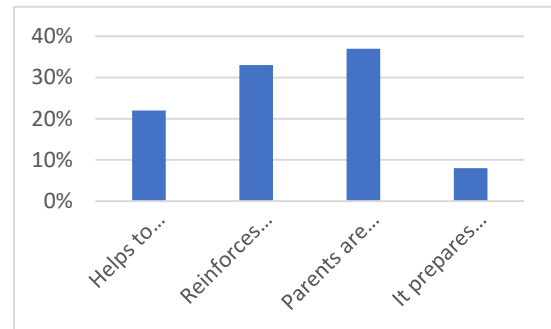
Question 8 – Do you prefer your child to have set tasks for homework or a choice of tasks related to the topic?

Don't know	0%



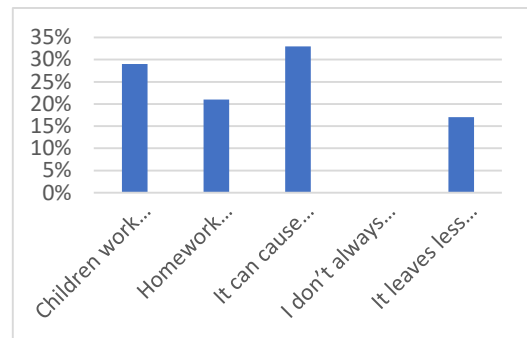
Question 9 – What do you consider to be the benefits of homework?
