Activity 1 - Religion, Values and Ethics (RVE)

Religious Winter Festivals

Christmas is a well-known religious festival that is celebrated in winter. Use the Internet to find out more about a different religious winter festival. You could choose Hanukkah, Yule, Saturnalia, Epiphany, Nirvana Day or any other. Write about who celebrates the festival, when it is celebrated, how it is celebrated and any other interesting facts. You can present the way in any way you wish.

Activity 2 - Write a Winter Haiku

A haiku is a form of poem. The features of haiku are:

- three lines
- five syllables on the first line
- seven syllables on the second line
- five syllables on the third line

Jot down any words or phrases that you associate with winter.

Then, experiment putting them into the form of a haiku.

Activity 3 - Winter Recipe

As winter is very cold, people like to eat warm, filling food, such as soup or stews. Find a recipe for something you think people would enjoy eating during the winter. You could use recipe books, cookery magazines or the Internet. Write out the recipe and illustrate. Perhaps you could try making the food?

Activity 4 - Write a Book Review

Write a book review for a book that you've read recently. Tell a friend what you enjoyed (or didn't enjoy!) You can talk about the plot and your favourite character. Remember to draw a picture!
