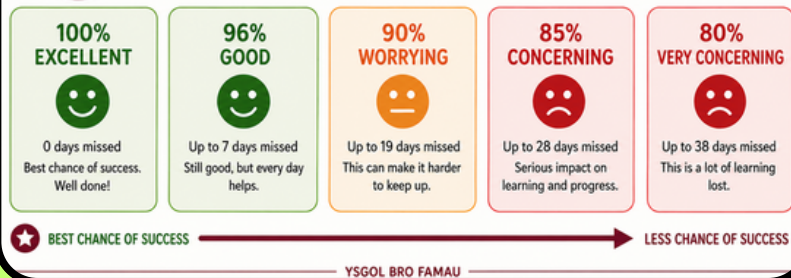

WHAT DOES ATTENDANCE REALLY MEAN?

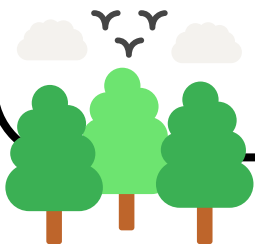


REMEMBER
